Our Purpose – Why We Created the World Youth Rugby 10s Series

The World Youth Rugby 10s Series was created from a simple belief — that young people deserve access to world-class sporting experiences regardless of where they live. Through international competition, travel, and cultural connection, we aim to broaden horizons, build confidence, and create opportunities that shape young people into capable, resilient, and respectful global citizens.

As an organisation deeply committed to youth development, we recognised the need for a professionally delivered international tournament that prioritises player experience, safety, fairness, and meaningful engagement both on and off the field. The World Youth Rugby 10s Series is our response to that need — a platform where young athletes can test themselves, represent their communities, and grow as individuals.

This tournament is not just about rugby. It is about creating moments that inspire ambition, strengthen character, and build friendships that last a lifetime.

We are truly grateful for the commitment shown by players, families, coaches, and supporters who have trusted us with this journey. Your willingness to travel, compete, and represent your communities is what brings this event to life. Together, we are creating more than a tournament — we are building friendships, developing young leaders, and delivering experiences that will be remembered long after the final whistle. We look forward to welcoming you to the field and sharing an unforgettable experience together.



TEAM ENTRY CONFIRMATION – GUIDELINES & CONDITIONS

To ensure fairness, transparency, and effective tournament planning, all teams seeking to participate in the **World Youth Rugby 10s Series** must follow the official entry and confirmation process outlined below.

1. Fees

Tournament **Team Entry Cost**: \$1,800 USD per team (includes local taxes)

Team entry fee includes: Team tent with table and chairs, ice, water, game day Physiotherapist & medical support.

2. Official Team Entry Requirement

All teams must submit their entry via the **official online Team Entry Form** found at www.WYR10S.COM

Entries submitted through any other method (email, message, or verbal request) will **not** be considered a valid entry.

Submission of the online entry form constitutes an **official request to participate** in the tournament but does **not** guarantee acceptance into the event.

3. Entry Confirmation Process

A team will only be deemed officially entered into the tournament once the following steps have been completed:

- The **Team Entry Form** has been submitted in full
- All requested documentation has been provided
- The Organising Committee has reviewed and approved the entry
- Applicable entry fees or deposits have been received when requested
- A formal **Entry Confirmation Notice** has been issued to the team

Until written confirmation is provided by the Organising Committee, a team is not considered accepted into the tournament.

4. Limited Team Positions

Team positions in each age division are limited to maintain a high-quality competition structure and player experience.

- Entries will be assessed and confirmed subject to eligibility and compliance requirements
- Once a division reaches capacity, additional teams may be placed on a **waiting list**
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to close entries at any time once capacity is reached

5. Accuracy of Information

Teams are responsible for ensuring that all information provided is accurate and complete.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Team name and age division
- Player eligibility and age compliance
- Contact details for the Team Manager or responsible official
- Emergency and safeguarding information (where applicable)

Providing false, misleading, or incomplete information may result in:

- Removal from the tournament
- Forfeiture of entry position

6. Communication Responsibility

All official communication regarding team entry will be sent to the nominated **Team Manager or primary contact** listed on the entry form.

Teams are responsible for:

- Monitoring their email communications
- Responding to requests for information in a timely manner
- Ensuring contact details remain current

Failure to respond to communication within required timeframes may result in loss of the team's reserved position.

7. Authority to Enter a Team

By submitting the Team Entry Form, the individual completing the form confirms that they:

- Have the authority to enter the team into the tournament
- Have obtained approval from the club, school, or organisation they represent
- Agree to comply with all tournament rules, policies, and participation requirements

8. Entry Withdrawal

If a team wishes to withdraw from the tournament after submitting an entry, written notification must be provided to the Organising Committee as soon as possible.

Early notification allows the Organising Committee to:

- Offer the position to another team
- Maintain competition balance
- Ensure fair participation opportunities for all teams

Any refund or cancellation conditions will be outlined separately in the tournament Terms and Conditions.

9. Team Registration Refunds

Full or minimum payment (\$500 USD) due at time of registration. Non-refundable deposit \$500 USD,

Full registration payment by November 1st 2027

Refunds excluding non- refundable deposit may apply to teams before January 31st 2027

NO refunds after January 31st 2027

TOURNAMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These Terms and Conditions apply to all teams, players, coaches, officials, parents, and supporters participating in the **World Youth Rugby 10s Series** (the Tournament). By submitting a Team Entry Form and participating in the Tournament, all participants agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

1. Tournament Authority

This event has been sanctioned by **USA Rugby**.

All participating teams are required to provide evidence of their approval to tour issued from their national rugby union body.

The **World Youth Rugby 10s Series Organising Committee** is responsible for the planning, delivery, and administration of the Tournament.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- Interpret and enforce all Tournament rules and policies
- Make decisions in the best interests of participant safety and event delivery
- Amend schedules, formats, or arrangements where necessary
- Refuse or withdraw entry where teams fail to comply with requirements

All decisions of the Organising Committee are final.

2. Eligibility and Age Requirements

All players must be the age of their nominated division, or turning that age, on or before the tournament game day dates. Players older than the designated age division are not eligible to participate.

All players must be eligible to compete in the age division in which they are entered.

Teams must ensure:

- Players meet the age eligibility requirements for their division
- Proof of age can be provided if requested
- Players are registered and authorised to participate by their club, school, or governing body
- Players are medically fit to participate in contact sport

The Organising Committee reserves the right to verify eligibility at any time.

Any team found to have fielded an ineligible player may face:

- Match forfeiture
 - Removal from the Tournament
 - Disqualification from the Tournament

3. Player Sharing Between Teams

Player sharing between teams may be permitted to support team participation and ensure balanced competition; however, strict eligibility requirements apply.

Players may only be shared **up one age division** and must originate from the immediate younger age group.

For example:

- **U16 players may play up in the U18 division**
- **U14 players may play up in the U16 division**
- **U14 players are not permitted to play up in the U18 division**

Under no circumstances may a player participate in an age division more than one level above their eligible age group.

All player sharing arrangements:

- **Must be declared to the Tournament Manager prior to participation in EACH GAME**
- **Must be validated and approved by the Tournament Manager**
- **Must comply with all eligibility and safety requirements**

Any player participating without prior approval may be deemed ineligible, and the team may be subject to disciplinary action, including match forfeiture.

4. Tournament Format and Schedule

The Tournament format, match schedule, and division structure will be determined by the Organising Committee.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- Adjust match schedules

- Modify competition format
 - Combine or restructure divisions
 - Cancel or postpone matches due to weather, safety, or operational requirements

5. Player Safety and Welfare

Participant safety is the highest priority.

All teams must:

- Follow the **World Rugby Rules** of rugby as determined by the Tournament
- Comply with all safety and medical requirements
- Provide appropriate supervision for their players at all times
- Ensure players use appropriate protective equipment

The Organising Committee reserves the right to remove any player, team, or individual from participation where safety concerns arise.

6. Code of Conduct

All participants are expected to behave in a respectful and sportsmanlike manner.

This applies to:

- Players
- Coaches
- Team officials
- Tournament officials
- Parents and spectators

Unacceptable behaviour includes:

- Abuse of referees or officials
- Aggressive or unsafe conduct
- Bullying, harassment, or discrimination
- Damage to facilities or property
- Failure to follow Tournament instructions

Any persons breaching the code of conduct will be subject to disciplinary action.

The Organising Committee may take disciplinary action, including:

- Warnings
 - Match forfeiture
 - Disqualification
 - Removal from the Tournament
 - Suspension from future events

7. Insurance and Medical Responsibility

All participating teams are responsible for ensuring that all participants have their own appropriate:

- Medical clearance to participate
- Travel and medical insurance (for international teams)
- Personal accident coverage where required

The Tournament does not offer or provide the above insurances for participating teams.

The Tournament will provide appropriate event safety and emergency procedures; however, participants attend and compete at their own risk.

8. Photography and Media Consent

The Tournament may capture photographs, video, and media content during the event.

By participating, teams and participants acknowledge that:

- Images and footage may be used for promotional, marketing, and reporting purposes
 - Content may be published on websites, social media, and media platforms
 - No compensation will be payable for use of such content

9. Weather and Force Majeure

The Tournament will proceed in most weather conditions; however, safety remains the priority.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- Delay or cancel matches

- Modify the schedule
- Suspend play

Where circumstances beyond reasonable control occur, including:

- Severe weather
- Natural disasters
- Venue closure
- Government restrictions
- Safety risks

the Tournament may be modified, postponed, or cancelled.

10. Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law:

- The Organising Committee is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft of personal property
- Participants assume responsibility for their own safety and conduct
- Teams are responsible for supervising their players and supporters

Participation in the Tournament is voluntary and at the participant's own risk.

11. Withdrawal and Cancellation

Teams wishing to withdraw must provide written notice to the Organising Committee.

Withdrawal may result in:

- Loss of entry position
- Application of cancellation conditions
- Replacement of the team from the waiting list

Refund conditions, if applicable, will be communicated separately.

12. Compliance with Local Laws and Venue Rules

All participants must comply with:

- Local laws and regulations
- Venue rules and safety requirements
- Instructions from Tournament staff and officials

Failure to comply may result in removal from the Tournament.

These Terms and Conditions exist to ensure a safe, fair, and professionally delivered tournament experience for every participant. By working together and respecting these requirements, we create an environment where young athletes can compete, grow, and enjoy the game of rugby.
